Troy Police Department Seeks Owners of Found Property

Two rather significant items of found property were reported to the Troy Police Department in the recent past. First, a woman's formal gold and diamond bracelet was found at Somerset Mall in early September. No owner has come forward as of yet. Second, a large basketball pole and hoop was found on Ronald Street last week. It is one of the portable types with a sand base and wheels. Whenever property is found and turned in to the department, it is maintained in an effort to locate an owner and return it. Should an owner not come forward, such items become subject to public auction.
